Watch Out for Scam Texts and Emails

There have been some scam texts and emails going around again claiming to be from Fr. Ray.

PLEASE REMEMBER that Fr. Ray will NEVER contact you by personal email to ask for money or a favor. HE WILL NOT:

- 1. Send you a text or email "asking for assistance"
- 2. Send you a text or an email asking for money
- 3. Sign texts of emails with "Rev" or "Reverend"
- 4. Send email from any other address than his DOR email (@dor.org).

If you get a suspicious text or email, DO NOT RESPOND and DO NOT CLICK ANY LINKS. Block the sender and report it to the office. If you are unsure, you can always call the office at (585)235-3340.

Here is an example of a **scam** email:

From: "Rev. Raymond Fleming" <revp9102@gmail.com> Good afternoon.

I trust this message finds you in good health and uplifted in spirit. I am reaching out with a sincere request and would be deeply grateful for your kind assistance. At your earliest convenience, I kindly ask that you email me it would mean a great deal to me. Thank you sincerely for your time and thoughtful consideration. May God's abundant grace, peace, and blessings continue to be with you always.
