

Its namesake, Dr. Kenneth Woodward, played a major role in building four neighborhood health centers. He was URMC Dean for Minority Affairs and Professor of Pediatrics from 1992 until his death in 1996. Some

may recall his first **Westside Health Center** in 1973 was housed for 10
years in the former St. Monica
Church Convent behind our church
parking lot!
